Easy Strawberry Shortcake

Ingredients:
 Small marshmallows
 1 white cake mix
 1 package strawberry Jell-O
 1 package frozen strawberries
 1 container Cool Whip

Directions:

Layer pan with marshmallows. Mix cake mix according to directions. Microwave strawberries to thaw for 1 min. Add Jell-O. Sprinkle a layer of marshmallows over cake. Put Jell-O and Strawberry mixture over marshmallows. Bake according to directions on box. Refrigerate. When cake is cooled add Cool Whip on top and serve.

Have fun making homemade bubbles with your child

What You Need

- ◆ 1/2 cup Dishwashing detergent (120 ml)
- ◆ 4 1/2 Cup Water (1.1 liter)
- ◆ 4 Tablespoons glycerin (60 ml) (available at pharmacies)
- ◆ Container with a tight fitting lid in which to keep the bubbles
- ◆ Measuring devices
- ◆ Spoon

How To Make It

1. Gather all your supplies.
2. Measure out the water, detergent, and glycerin into container.
3. GENTLY stir the mixture together. If a foam forms, gently skim it off the top.
4. Find something with which to blow bubbles and begin to have fun.



Note: The longer you let the mixture set, the larger the bubbles are and the longer they seem to last.
