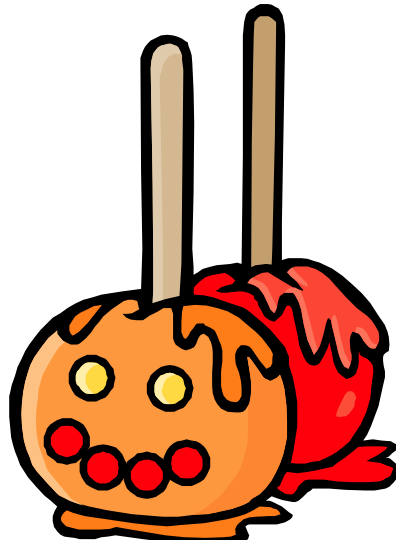
Dear Families,

Goopy Caramel Apples

- 1 1/2 teaspoon butter
- 1 1/2 cups brown sugar
- 6 tablespoons water
- Popsicle sticks
- 8 apples

Melt the butter in a saucepan. Add the brown sugar and water. Stir until it has a smooth consistency. Gently bring to a boil, then cover and simmer for 3 minutes, until the sides of the pan get steamy and the mixture is thin but somewhat sticky. Remove from heat. Pierce the center of each apple with a popsicle stick, then swirl in the caramel until coated. Place apples on a greased cookie sheet to harden. Refrigerate for at least 1 to 2 hours. Serves 8.

Autumn Activities for You and Your Child

Making Leaf Prints

What you'll need:

- ◆ Leaves of all colors, shapes and sizes
- ◆ Wax paper
- ◆ Iron and a towel to protect tabletop



Instructions:

Take a nice walk through the woods or park and look for fall leaves of all colors, especially golds and reds. Then at home set your iron on medium heat, adults please help younger children with the ironing. Take a piece of wax paper large enough to fit several leaves. Arrange the leaves any way you like on top of the paper. Cover the leaves with another sheet of wax paper. Iron until the paper seals in the leaves. A construction paper frame can be cut and added as a mat for your collage.
